ARVANA - ARVANA is doing well overall. We have had good meeting attendance and have had successful events including the Grateful Heads' Freak Out, Straight Forward Group's Annual Unity Day and Games, RAW Group -Fort Smith 10th Anniversary, and Game Night, to name a few over the last three months. New Start is having their Family Fun Day today at Merritt Park in Dardanelle.

Currently we have the following nine groups hosting 56 meetings per week that are seated within the Arkansas River Valley Area of Narcotics Anonymous:

Easy Does It – Meetings are held weekly on Mondays and Fridays at 7pm. Mostly newcomers and people with a year or less clean time. Looking for people with longer term recovery to attend meetings and to sponsor. Meetings are held at Project Church at 312 W Main St, Clarksville. Speaker meeting the last Friday of the month with food starting at 6pm.

Friends for Freedom – Meetings are held weekly on Thursdays and Sundays at 6pm at Shiloh Baptist Church in Russellville. Attendance is good currently.

Grateful Heads Group – Daily meeting at noon and 630pm. Birthday night and fellowship is every second Sunday of the month with a monthly theme and food with chips following. Thursday night there are separate men's and women's meetings at 630pm. Meetings are held at 1321 Knoxville St in Fort Smith. The Freeze Out is scheduled tentatively for the third weekend in January 2024. The Freak Out went GREAT at Cherokee Landing at Tenkiller State Park.

New Start – Monday night literature study at 7pm and Tuesdays at 7pm and Thursdays at 8pm at 209 Union Street in Dardanelle. Recently started a noon meeting up again at the Dardanelle Community Center at 2011 Hwy 22 on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

New Way – Good attendance and support. Has the Ice Cream Social coming up on 8/12/23 at 2PM. Meetings are being held on Sundays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays at 7pm at 23 N 20^{th} St, Van Buren in the VFW building. First Sunday of the month is birthday night.

Poteau Hard Core – Meetings are held at 103 Church Street in the courthouse annex in Poteau, OK and they have been struggling some with regular meeting attendance. Mondays and Thursdays at 7pm.

 $RAW\ Group$ – Meetings are Monday, Wednesday and Thursday nights at 6pm. These are informal literature study meetings and Thursdays are dedicated to step working time. Meetings are located at 514 N 11th St in Fort Smith. Recently held their 10th Anniversary Speaker Jam at People Inc in Sallisaw, OK. Attendance was lower than in previous years and they believe that this was due to their location being across state lines.

Straight Forward Group – Daily meetings at 7am, noon, and 8pm. Professionals in Recovery closed NA meeting being held on Saturdays at 2pm. Birthday night is the last Friday of the month and speakers are every other Friday night. Thursday night is literature study. Meetings are located at 514 N 11th St in Fort Smith. Fall Serenity Gathering and campout is being held Labor Day Weekend, September 1-3, 2023 at Devil's Den State Park near Winslow, AR. The Unity Day games went well over Memorial Day Weekend and we are tentatively planning for Halloween Dance and Holiday Marathon Meetings for Thanksgiving and Christmas/New Year's Eve. Yellow Frogs Resurrection – Recently held their second ever fundraiser/event and had a good turnout for game night and speaker. The group currently has weekly meetings on Tuesday and Saturday nights at 6pm and Saturday night at 10pm. Meetings are located at 514 N 11th St in Fort Smith.

There is a group trying to gain traction in Mulberry, at the Memaw's Café on Sundays at 5pm. There has been some recent interest to start a meeting up in Ozark again.

H&I/PR Committee is currently going into the People Inc Juvenile/Youth center, Sebastian County Detention Center, Crawford County Detention Center, Sebastian County Juvenile Detention Center, Gateway Treatment Center, and Harbor House with H&I meetings. Lee P. from Louisiana resigned from SZF FD as coordinator due to urgent family issues. Craig G. (PR liaison) is currently serving as the interim FD coordinator.

Fellowship Development:

I gathered addresses to all 95 county jail facilities in Arkansas and provided them to the FD committee. The contact and return email is Craig G. at this time, due to trusted servants changing over the next several months.

I am making my amends to this Region for a recent (deleted) post on Facebook. I made a post that read "I am so disappointed in the Arkansas Region of Narcotics Anonymous." I deleted it a few hours later, but not before someone screenshot it and sent it to an RSC member who is blocked from my FB account, which was harmful to me.

I deeply regret making the post. It directly affects our public image. I will not ever defame Narcotics Anonymous again. I love Narcotics Anonymous and am not happy that I caused harm to our fellowship.

My feelings of disappointment remain. An audit of the RSC bank account, outgoing treasurer's records and bookkeeping has still not been completed. I have said it before – We as a service body need to be better and do better at follow through. Our words and actions do not match.
