



What's something people forget *is* service?














- Being the group's unofficial gossip hub






- Release a NA rap album





Name a skill you don't need experience for, but can grow while serving.














- Mastering the art of passive-aggressive minutes



- Fixing the meeting format with duct tape and hope




- Advanced meme usage to explain Concepts

- Print recovery messages on fortune cookies




